

BC OUGHT TO HAVE AN Endangered Species Law

To the Honourable Legislative Assembly of the Province of British Columbia, in Legislature Assembled:

Whereas British Columbia is one of only two provinces in Canada without an endangered species law, leaving over 1900 species at risk without adequate legal protection,



Whereas British Columbia is a globally significant refuge for North American wildlife, and the most biologically rich province in Canada,

Whereas over 80% of British Columbians support strong and effective endangered species legislation,

Your petitioners request that the Honourable House adopt an endangered species law that is based on the best possible peer-reviewed science, protects and recovers species at risk by protecting their critical and recovery habitat, and requires accountability and transparency to the public.
