South Nopiming Multi-Use Trail system



The Nopiming 4 Lakes 4 Wheelers Inc. is a newly formed volunteer organization founded by cabin owners in the south Nopiming Provincial Park area. We represent the interests of responsible All Terrain Vehicle users in the southern 4 lakes region of Nopiming Park where we are seeking to preserve, enhance and maintain the long utilized and appreciated wilderness trails in the area.

The vision we have for the trail network is of a rustic, challenging, safe, environmentally sustainable, multi-

use trail system connecting the four lakes region of Nopiming Provincial Park. It will be maintained by our club in conjunction with ATV MB, monitored by Manitoba Conservation and Climate, and safely enjoyed by all nature lovers who come to the vast interesting wilderness that is Nopiming Provincial Park. Staging areas at the beginning of each major trail will allow for trailering vehicles to the trails.

We are working closely with the Parks and Protected Spaces Branch of Manitoba Conservation and Climate and ATV Manitoba to effectively balance environmental sustainability with trail use.

We are conducting a consultation process with stakeholders to collect input associated with this trail system as part of it being officially sanctioned and designated for public use. We have attached a map of the trail system proposal which is largely made up of existing logging roads and trails with a few connector trails developed to interconnect the 4 lake communities.

Trail Designation Process and Next Steps:

- 1. Become a Trail Group with ATV Manitoba Completed
- 2. Develop Trail Proposal Completed
- 3. Consultation on Trail Proposal Current Step
- 4. Adjust Trail and Provide Mitigations In Proposal for Route Approval by Manitoba Conservation and Climate
- Plan work to open trail a section at a time.
- Annual Maintenance and Work by Volunteers
